Election of a Town Councillor for Watchet Town Council

1. Forms of nomination for the Town Council Election may be obtained from West Somerset House, Killick Way, Williton, TA4 4QA from the Returning Officer who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature. 2. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer, West Somerset House, Killick Way, Williton, TA4 4QA by appointment only between Tuesday 23rd March and 4pm on Thursday 8th April 2021. Please contact Electoral Services on 01823 358692 or email: elections@somersetwestandtaunton.gov.uk to make an appointment.
3. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday 6th May 2021.
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Monday 19th April 2021. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>
5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at West Somerset House, Killick Way, Williton, TA4 4QA by 5pm on Tuesday 20th April 2021.
6. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at West Somerset House, Killick Way, Williton, TA4 4QA by 5pm on Tuesday 27th April 2021.
7. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of a medical emergency or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at West Somerset House, Killick Way, Williton, TA4 4QA by 5pm on Thursday 6th May 2021. The medical emergency must have occurred after 5pm on Tuesday 27th April 2021. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Tuesday 27th April 2021.
